PURPLE MASH AND REMOTE LEARNING

Dear Parent,

During the school closure earlier this year, Brook Street School took the decision to provide the children with weekly work via the school website. Since returning to school in September, the school has bought each child a login into PURPLE MASH. PURPLE MASH is an online learning tool, which the children have access to during the school day and at home.

Our intention is to use Purple Mash to set weekly home learning tasks where necessary and have this as a backup should we find ourselves in another situation where school is closed and children have to learn remotely from home.

The children can sign in on the login in page using their user name and password.

FOR EXAMPLE : username: joes
password: 3098

Please note the password has a pictorial option for younger children who may forget a numerical password.

In this pack, you will find relevant information to support you using Purple Mash at home. Teachers have started to train the children in class. You may find if you logon together, your child may already be able to guide you through the site.

I have attached a welcome letter from purple Mash with your child's login. This also explains how you can access the site as a parent. However, I would advise you use your child's username and password to get started together.

The children in Nursery will access their work through the Mini Mash tab. I have attached relevant instructions from Purple Mash to help you with this.

The children in Reception to Year 6 will access their work through the 2DO tab. I have attached relevant instructions from Purple Mash to help you with this.

I will keep you updated on any changes. However, please contact school or your child's class teacher if you require any support in the meantime.
